Trinity Streets

"TRINITY STREETS" is a Good Shepherd outreach program through St. David's Trinity Center serving a Sunday meal 2:00-4:00 pm to homeless individuals and families. Generally four or five times each year, a team from Good Shepherd goes to the Trinity Center to help our clergy provide a brief service, Eucharist, and a meal to the Trinity Center neighbors.

The Trinity Center is located on the corner of 7th and Trinity, just below St. David's. Volunteers arrive at 2:00 pm to begin set up and food preparation before the 3:00 pm service and meal. We are generally finished by 4:00pm and everyone is welcome to help us serve. We also encourage students to consider this as a great opportunity for service hours.

Parish Administrator, Nancy Wade Set to Retire

ON FRIDAY, AUGUST 27, Nancy Wade will retire after thirteen years of service as Parish Administrator. Our longest-tenured full-time employee, Nancy has served with six Good Shepherd rectors and locum tenens, and her history in this parish and in service of The Episcopal Church extends far beyond her professional ministry at the corner of Windsor and Exposition.



The Wades formally arrived at Good Shepherd in 1967, when Nancy, along with her husband, Louis (and even her mother-in-law, Betty Wade!), were confirmed. The couple raised their children here, and both served in practically all manner of parish leadership, from Bazaar Chair to Vestry, Search Committees to Guilds.

Nancy's employment at Good Shepherd began in 1986, when she accepted a part-time position as the church's first Director of Christian Education. That first tenure ended when Nancy and Louis left for Houston in August of 1987. Even so, Nancy wasted little time finding fresh opportunities for service, when in 1987 she began serving as Parish Administrator of Holy Spirit Episcopal Church. Her ministry at Holy Spirit completed in 1993 when the Wade's moved to Wisconsin, where Nancy was selected as Senior Warden at Saint Anskar's in Hartland. In 1997, she was elected to serve as a Delegate to the convention of the Diocese of Milwaukee, when the family was called to return home to Austin. In May of that same year, Nancy accepted her current position here at GS.

In her work at Good Shepherd, Nancy transitioned the parish from the paper age to the digital era, shepherding us from a card catalogue of the parish's membership to a database, and from an accounting model based on a ten-key adding machine with a pull lever to the computer-based Automated Church Systems, or ACS. Moreover, she wore her hard hat with pride during the Capital

Campaign and most recent building project when the parish raised our current Administration Building. Managing her many charges with aplomb, Nancy leaves a legacy of hard work and servant leadership.

Please save the date for Saturday, August 28th at 5:00 pm as we join together in the Parish Hall to celebrate Nancy's ministry with a special evening affair of good memories, good company, and good fare. You will be receiving an invitation with a RSVP card in the mail come August with more information. We look forward to celebrating together, and please keep both Nancy and the parish in your prayers during this time of transition.

Public restrooms are available in the Administration building and the East Parish Hall (see map below).

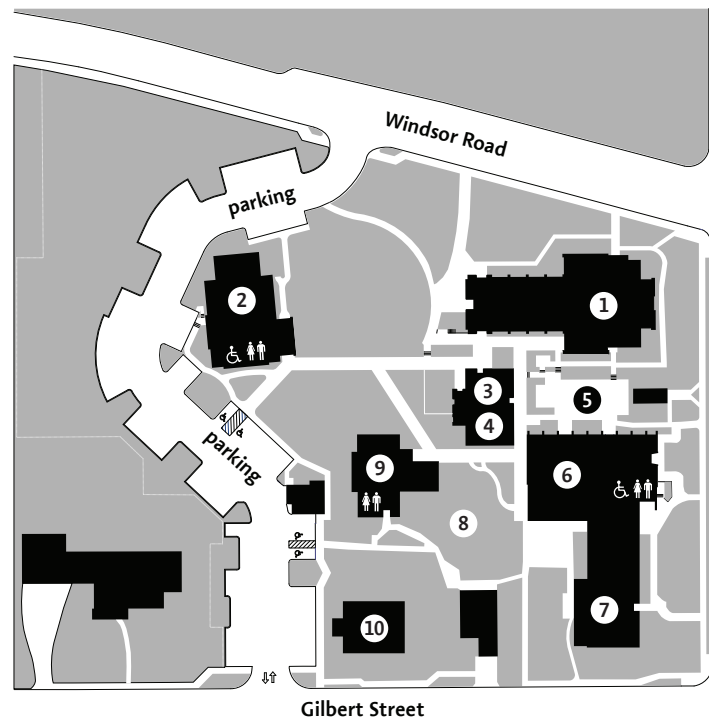
Parking
