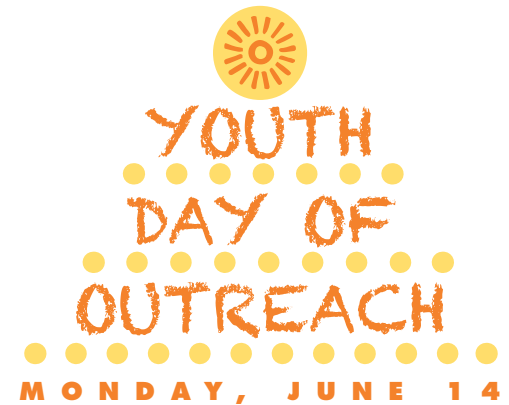
looking ahead

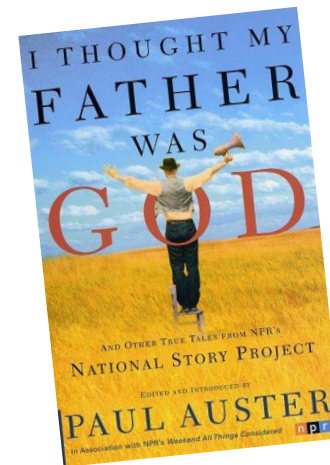
On August 22 we'll do the same, while on July 18 we'll sing at the 3:00 Trinity Streets Eucharist at St David's Church.

Good Shepherd Story Project

THIS WEEK WE KICK OFF the Good Shepherd Story Project! This is a great opportunity for anyone and everyone who would like to come and hear, write, and read some good stories.

WEEK OF JUNE 13

Reading stories from *I Thought My Father was God*, the collection of tales from NPR's National Story Project. You are invited to bring and read aloud one of your favorite stories, with the broad guideline that the story must be short (no more than two pages of a paperback book).

WEEK OF JUNE 20

Using a small group format, we will begin to write our own stories. We will discuss the tale we want to tell, receiving feedback and counsel from other members of our group about how to best record the story in writing.

WEEK OF JUNE 27

Finally, we will "workshop" our stories, reading aloud what we have written, and receiving constructive counsel from our friends about how we can enrich what we have already prepared. The parameters are simple: the stories should be 500 words or fewer; they have to be about you or your family; and they have to be true.

At the end of our time together, all are invited to submit their story to our larger parish project, which will be collected and published beginning in the fall. See you this summer!

Public restrooms are available in the Administration building and the East Parish Hall (see map below).

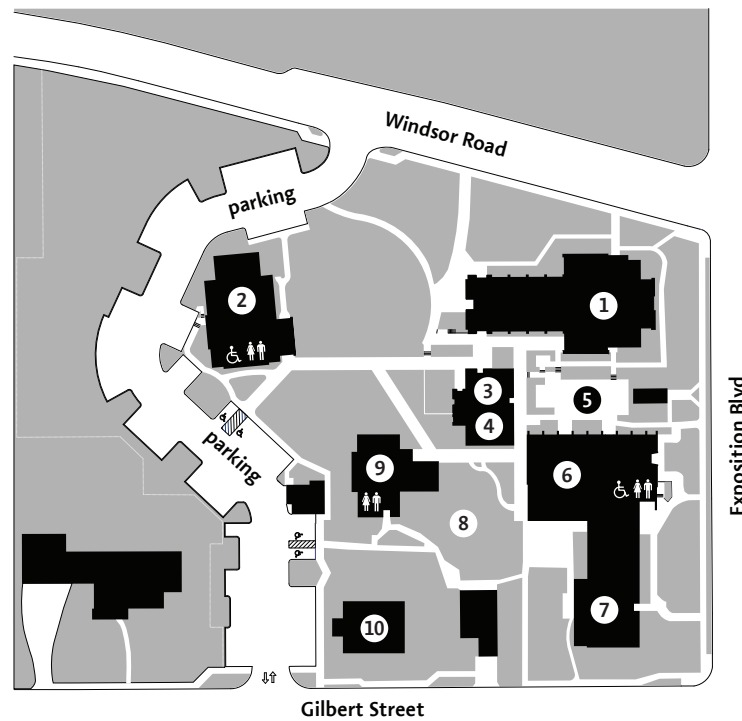
Parking
