

SUNDAY PARISH BREAKFAST FORUMS

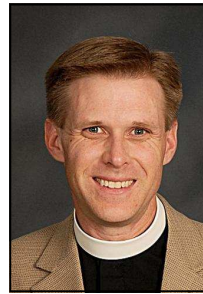

Our Lenten journey will begin on Ash Wednesday, February 17, when we at The Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd will gather for The Imposition of Ashes and the Holy Eucharist, at 7:00a, 12:00p, and 7:00p.

Thereafter, I invite you to make with me a commitment to daily worship. Beginning on Thursday, February 18, and continuing every weekday of Lent through Wednesday of Holy Week, March 31, we will gather at 7:00a in the Chapel for Communion and prayer. The Eucharist will finish no later than 7:30a, in time to take the kiddos to school, head to Moffett House for Yoga, or make your way to the office. For those with time to spare, following our time together we'll share coffee and conversation in the Administrative Building Foyer and Conference Room.

We will share responsibility for reading, offering prayers, and serving Communion, keeping our promise to "pray, read, and meditate on God's holy Word, and to make a right beginning" as we prepare ourselves for the Easter feast. I hope we will journey together this Lent.

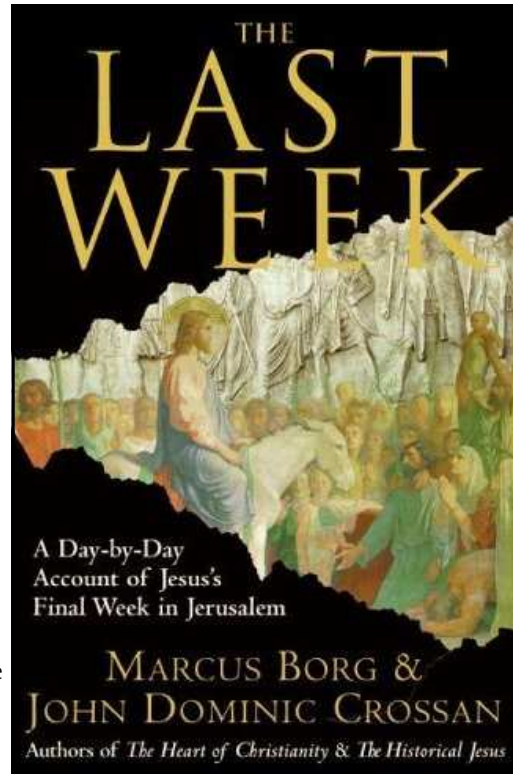

During Lent, our weekday studies—including the Tuesday evening Men's Bible & Brew; and the Thursday Morning Women's Study—will consider the celebrations and laments of the Psalms. In *The Rock of our Salvation*, our Curate, the Rev. Chris Duncan will explore the roots of so much of our Church's song and prayer. Rendered from the Hebrew word for praise, Psalms offer an insight into the struggles and joys of life, encompassing the range of the human experience in relationship with God.

The Men's Bible & Brew will begin the series on February 23, and continue to meet on Tuesday evenings in the Conference Room from 6:30-8:30p. The Thursday Morning Women's Study will begin the series on February 25, and continue to meet on Thursday mornings in the Choir Room from 10:00-11:30a.

AUSTIN MARATHON ON FEBRUARY 14

Despite the race, you can still easily get to worship on Sunday, February 14! Here's how: from the north, take Balcones south and turn right onto Pecos and then east to Windsor, totally avoiding the race. From the south, take MoPac to the Enfield Road exit and turn right onto Exposition. You will travel with the runners, but they will be in the other (southbound) lane. The intersection of Windsor Road at Exposition will be controlled by the Austin Police Department, and officers will direct you to turn left in breaks of the runners.

LENTEN WORSHIP & STUDY

Would you like to gain a deeper, more worshipful sense of the Lenten season? Beginning on Ash Wednesday, February 17, we will celebrate Holy Eucharist weekday mornings at 7:00a. These services will help us focus on the Lenten season with prayer, penitence, and reconciliation.



Sunday nights during Lent, Christian Education at 6:30p will center on *The Last Week: What the Gospels Really Teach About Jesus's Final Days in Jerusalem* by Marcus J. Borg and John Dominic Crosson. "The last week depicts Jesus giving up his life to protest power without justice...We not only meet the historical Jesus, but meet a new Jesus who engages us and invites us to follow him." Books will be available for purchase at the first class meeting.



Men's Bible & Brew, the Thursday Morning Women's Bible Study, and the Friday Bible Study will all study Psalms for five weeks beginning February 23.

Within the very roots of the Christian faith, the Psalms have played an important role in song and prayer. After a couple of weeks of well-deserved Christmas vacation, the GS Choir started the New Year singing at the Feast of the Epiphany, followed with a Twelfth Night party at the Crooms'. Two other Wednesday night services—Chris Duncan's ordination, and soon Ash Wednesday—in addition to regular Sunday duties have made for a busy schedule for this dedicated group of parishioners! Meanwhile,—just after a busy Christmas of their own, the Primary and Junior Choirs sang Choral Evensong for the first time in recent memory, reminding us that the liturgy is the common heritage and property of the whole Church, young and old alike.

In Lent at the 9:00a Sunday Eucharist we return to some plainsong service music we last sang in Advent—settings historically specified for use in those two seasons as well as at Requiems, as indeed we did last October—but having learned these pieces with the aid of the organ, we will now sing them as they are meant to be sung: by voices alone, in all their unadorned beauty.

Every Sunday Eucharist is a Feast of the Resurrection, which is the basic celebration of the Church. The changing seasons and the other feasts and fasts of the Church, however, and all the ways we mark them, allow us to focus on different aspects of our faith and to be inspired by the lives of Jesus and his followers.


