Update on Flooding



ALL ABATEMENT WORK has been completed. As was true last week, all of our parish programming will continue as planned, as neither the flood nor restoration work affected or will affect any of the church's worship or meeting areas. You may trust that our campus is safe for you and your family, and that we are taking every precaution and necessary step to ensure the safety of GSES and the Education Building.

When you arrive on campus, you will find that there are still several construction containers in our parking lot. For this reason, we ask that on Sunday all able-bodied folk park on the street or in the parking lot across the street, in order that our mobility-impaired parishioners may have benefit of the best parking spaces.

As for GSES, we have received a Temporary Relocation Permit from the Department of Family and Protective Services, which enabled our school to start back up last Monday, September 20, in alternative spaces around our campus. Teachers, staff, and friends have been hard at work moving classroom equipment for the temporary relocation while the flooring of GSES is being restored.

Thank you again for your patience and for your support of our parish. As always, I invite your prayers as we continue working together for the good of God's Kingdom here at the corner of Windsor and Exposition.

Public restrooms are available in the Administration building and the East Parish Hall (see map below).

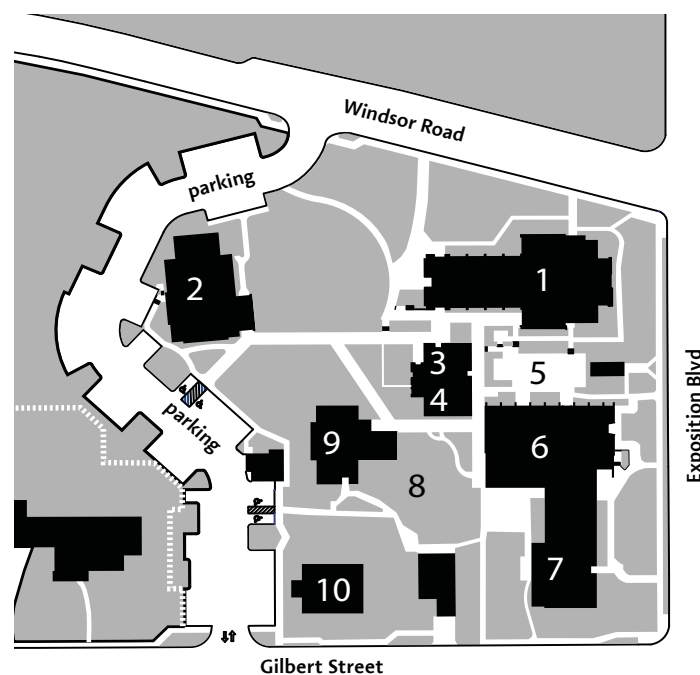
Parking
