Whistle with me the final stanza of Charles Wesley’s hymn, “Love divine, all loves excelling”:

*Finish, then, thy new creation; pure and spotless let us be.
Let us see thy great salvation, perfectly restored in thee;
changed from glory into glory, till in heaven we take our place,
till we cast our crowns before thee, lost in wonder, love, and praise.*

We know so many blessings here at Good Shepherd: as announced at our Annual Parish Meeting last month, we will retire our debt this year and, despite the challenges of the economy, we ended 2010 with a substantial budget surplus. We are a growing congregation and have celebrated more baptisms in the last two years than any parish in The Diocese of Texas, save only one (which happens to be the largest Episcopal church in the country). We are a vibrant community, reaching out with new ministries in service of our parish family, the city of Austin, and the world.

To continue celebrating this rich inheritance of blessing, we at Good Shepherd need now to open ourselves to transformation: clearly not from failure to success, or infidelity to faithfulness, but “From Glory into Glory.” As Paul wrote to the church at Corinth: “Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And all of us, with unveiled faces, seeing the glory of the Lord as though reflected in a mirror, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another; for this comes from the Lord, the Spirit” (2 Corinthians 3:17-18). From “one degree of glory to another,” God asks us to open ourselves to the Spirit of renewal, as individuals and as a community of faith.

Beginning on Sunday, February 13, we will undertake deliberate and directed discernment about how God is calling Good Shepherd – **now** – to be transformed “From Glory into Glory.”

PREPARE. This five-week program will have two components: Sunday presentations during the customary Adult Education hour, and weekday small groups – called “Glory Groups” – to reflect on the presentations. On Sundays, Charlie Cook and I will lead discussions in response to this Gospel theology, employing C. Kirk Hadaway’s book, *Behold I Do a New Thing*, as a guiding text. On weekdays, members of our Program, Clergy, and Administrative Staffs will facilitate the response sessions.

MAKE ROOM. To accommodate the meeting of the nine Glory Groups, we will suspend several of our regularly convening weekday studies, including the Monday evening Men’s Bible & Brew; the Tuesday evening Late Night @ GS; and the Thursday morning Women’s Study. Additionally, two of the Women on the Journey groups will effectually become Glory Groups, as well.

DISCERN. After “From Glory into Glory” completes its first phase during the week of March 13, we will not reconvene these other groups for the balance of Lent. During those succeeding weeks, we commit to a season of discernment about all of our ministries’ identities and their respective places in our larger community of transformation. On Wednesday evenings, we will host a Lenten supper and discussion series supporting us with models and methods of discernment.

REPORT. “From Glory into Glory” will then reconvene for the Second and Third Sundays of Easter – May 1 and May 8 – repeating its Sunday format and the Glory Groups’ weekday meeting times. Everyone will be invited to bring back to our discussion what we missed, learned, and came to recognize about the parish’s life as a result of our Lenten discernment.

ACT. These Easter conversations will serve as brainstorming sessions as we begin planning for the 2011-2012 Program Year.

The scale of this endeavor is substantial, and the parish needs your participation. I ask you to make a four-week commitment – from Sunday, February 13, through the week of Sunday, March 6 – covenanting to attend church and Adult Education (at 10:35a) every Sunday, and to participate in one of the attendant weekday Glory Groups. The Glory Groups’ meeting times have been sprinkled through the days of the week, hopefully, to match with your availability in the morning, at lunchtime, or in the evening.

Charlie and I, along with your Glory Group facilitator, will work with everyone to enable your participation.

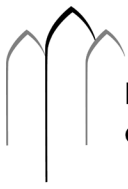
