A fellow children's director recently shared a story about a group of five to six year-old Sunday School students. It was the end of the year, and the final story was what had also been the first one of the year: the story of the Good Shepherd. Yet this time, the idea of the Good Shepherd was linked to the modern church. This may sound heavy for a group of youngsters but props were used to help make the connection and transition. A small altar was placed on the floor, the shepherd figure was replaced by a Jesus figure and small wooden people replaced the sheep. At the conclusion of the story the teacher asked the children to go to the shelves and pull out anything else that reminded them of God or about the story. Various items were placed on the altar with the children explaining their choices. One little girl who had been shy and hesitant all year sat very quietly. Finally, after all the other children had gone to the altar, she slowly walked to the shelves and very carefully picked up the wolf. As she placed the wolf on the altar another student asked in a distressed tone, "Why did you put that wolf there?" The little girl replied, "Don't you think God would let the wolf come to the table, too?"

ROOM AT THE TABLE

Children not only deserve to be seen but they deserve to be heard! This astute message out of the mouth of a babe is one that we should all remember. God does let the wolf come to the table and the wolf can take many forms. Our hurts, fears, disappointments, pain, our prejudices and judgments, our mistakes of the past and present—God does let the wolf come to the table. He does make room and He does so through the redeeming grace of a babe born in a manger.

In the New Year let us without hesitation acknowledge and welcome the wolves at the table. Let us take heart that by doing so, we in turn make room in our lives for Christ's freely given grace. And, let us also have a desire and longing to continuously know Him. Let us do this for ourselves so that we in turn can be authentic models for our children. Let us sit down and read the Bible with our children, pray together with our children, let them hear us asking God for help and comfort and His grace and direction. Let us through our actions pass down to them how to practice our faith. And, let us show them and remind ourselves, that there is, and always will be, room at the table.

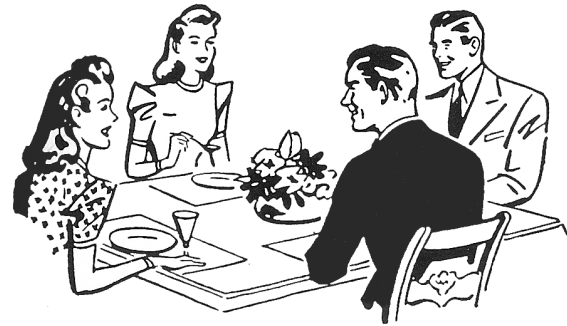

FOYER GROUPS

FOYER GROUPS ARE A FUN AND EASY WAY for parishioners to gather together on a regular but informal basis for purely social reasons



– to enjoy one another's company, to strengthen bonds of community, to meet new members and to get to know other people who share a common interest in Good Shepherd. They provide a means to develop new friendships and deepen old ones and are a way to make our sometimes-too-large-seeming parish feel smaller and warmer. With an architectural origin, "foyer" refers to a welcoming entrance to a home or church. In other churches or settings, these might be called "supper clubs".

There is no agenda or plan – just casual fellowship and a refreshing meal. Groups are made up of singles, couples, young people, retired folks, families with children, etc.– a cross section of the parish. Out of the meetings, friendships develop among people who otherwise may not have had an opportunity to meet and get to know one another. Newcomers are especially invited to join a Foyer Group.

Each small group of eight to twelve people meet monthly. The group decides whether to rotate through all the members' homes and make it a pot-luck or to meet at a local restaurant. There will be a Kick-Off Dinner at the Parish Hall on January 14, 2011 at 6:30p. The groups will be announced and divided up so that plans for the monthly dinner meetings can be made. 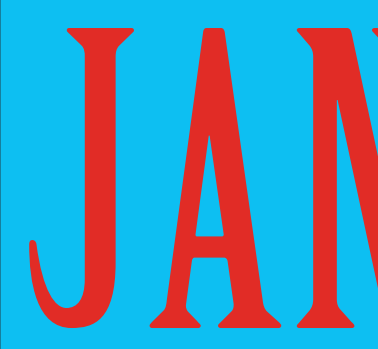

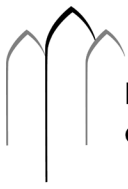
