Adult Education Returns!

OUR NEW FALL EDUCATION SERIES – *The Devil and All His Works* – begins today! Join us at 10:45 a.m. in the Parish Hall for a lively investigation of all things

diabolical. Over the course of 10 weeks, we'll examine the figure of Satan in the Bible and later Christian tradition, wrestle with the problem of evil, and reflect upon representations of the Devil and the demonic in popular culture. In time, we'll turn away from the dark side and look toward the light, concluding our journey with *The Spirit and All Her Works*.

Evensong

Evensong is an old name for what is now called Daily Evening Prayer in our Prayer Book; it is part of the Church's ancient and continuing round of services – the Daily Office – marking the hours of the day. Consisting essentially of psalms and canticles, scripture and prayers, Evensong (along with the rest of the Office – Matins or Daily Morning Prayer, Noontday Prayer, and Compline) is at heart a very simple, even contemplative service – but, graced with candlelight and incense, simple chant and the great wealth of choral music written for it over the centuries, it becomes an even richer feast of praise and prayer.

Join us this evening for Choral Evensong at 6:00pm. If you've never attended Evensong, plan to make it a part of your worship life and, as the Psalmist says, let your prayer be set forth as incense, the lifting up of your hands as the evening sacrifice.

Public restrooms are available in the Administration building and the East Parish Hall (see map below).

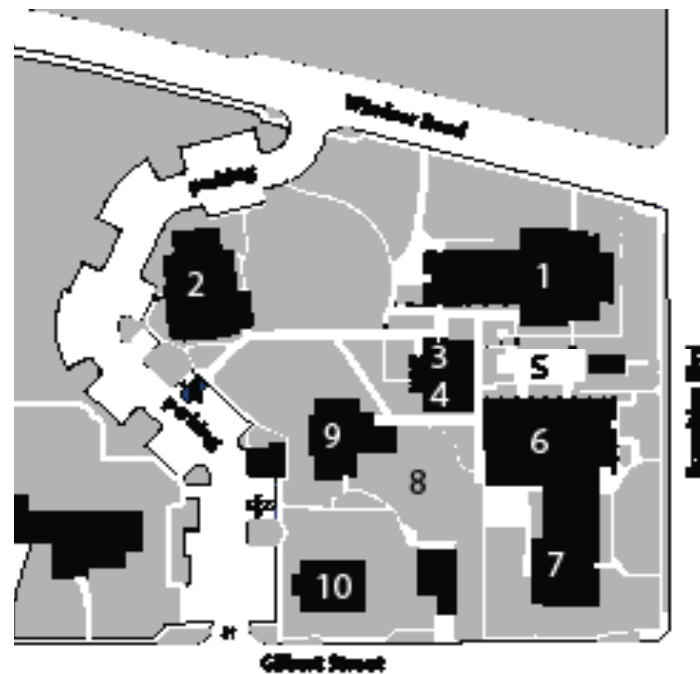
Parking
